


Compound Adjectives with Numbers

You can make compound adjectives with numbers by combining a number and a singular noun with a hyphen.



If the number is **less than 10**, write out the number (e.g., one, two, three).

a seven-day trip a five-year loan a one-hour class a two-person tent a four-door car If the number is **10 or greater**, use the numeral (e.g., 10, 50, 500).

a 12-hour shift a 30-year loan a 45-minute class a 26-mile run a 100-hour course
