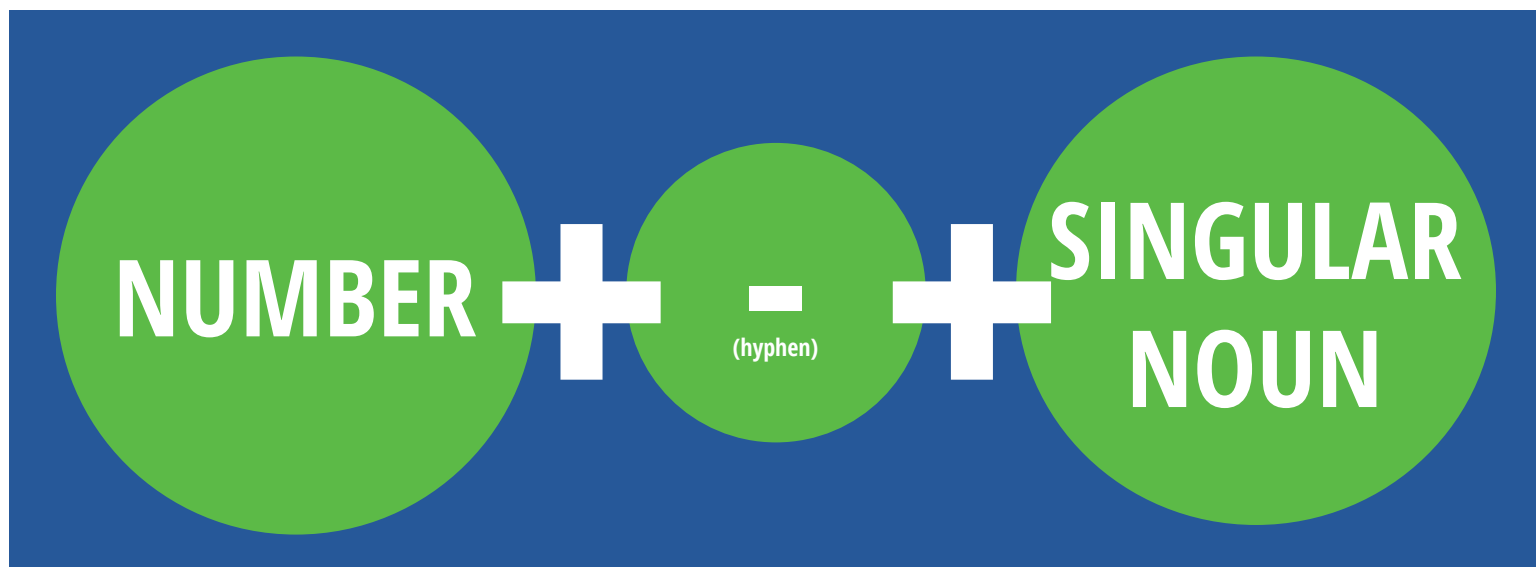


Compound Adjectives with Numbers

You can make compound adjectives with numbers by combining a number and a singular noun with a hyphen.



If the number is **less than 10**, write out the number (e.g., one, two, three).

a **seven-day** trip
 a **five-year** loan
 a **one-hour** class
 a **two-person** tent
 a **four-door** car

If the number is **10 or greater**, use the numeral (e.g., 10, 50, 500).

a **12-hour** shift
 a **30-year** loan
 a **45-minute** class
 a **26-mile** run
 a **100-hour** course
